Daimyo



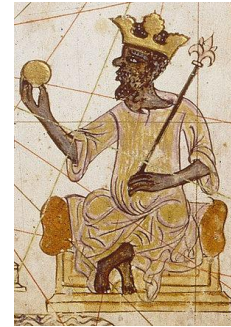
Warriors who lived by a code of behavior
