In the fourteenth century (1300s), the <u>Bubonic Plague</u> (Black Death) decimated the population of much of Asia and then the population of Europe. It was caused by a <u>bacteria</u> in infected fleas carried by rats. It began in <u>Asia</u> and spread to <u>Europe</u> via trade routes. The plague spread quickly due to <u>unsanitary conditions</u>.
